What's Happening?

**Air Quality Monitoring is starting for the All Season Community Access Road
October 26 - 30, 2020**

Study plans to guide the work have been reviewed and received approval from Chief and Council and the Pandemic Response Team.

Details about the Air Quality Monitoring:

- » The field crew conducting the air monitoring studies will be staying in community from October 26 to 30.
- » You may notice field crews in and working around the community.
- » An air monitoring device will be installed and will be operating for one year to collect baseline air quality data.
- » Please keep your distance from the monitoring device. A community member will be watching and maintaining the monitoring device.
- » Crews will return to perform regular maintenance on the device in the spring.

Provincial guidelines for COVID-19 will be followed including social distancing, daily screening questionnaires, Personal Protective Equipment and regular disinfection.
