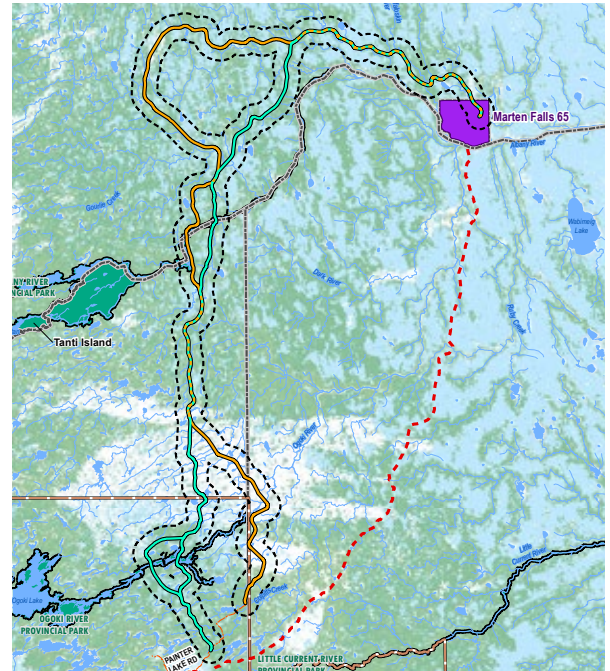
What's Happening?

Aquatic Surveys are starting for the All Season Community Access Road

October 14 - 25, 2020

Details about the Aquatic Field Studies:

- » Studies will be focused on major water crossings, and the information collected will be used to understand surface and groundwater conditions and fish habitat.
- » Water and sediment samples will be collected.
- » Fishing will not be part of these field studies.
- » The study areas will be accessed by helicopter between 7am and 7pm each day.
- » Field crews will stay in Geraldton each night.
- » Work will begin in the north and move south, weather permitting.



Corridors for Aquatic Field Studies

Provincial guidelines for COVID-19 will be followed including social distancing, daily screening questionnaires, Personal Protective Equipment and regular disinfection.
