# Field Notice

## April 2026 – UPDATE Vegetation Clearing

*Issued: April 7, 2026*

**Work is scheduled to start on April 11, 2026 (pending weather)**

### What's Happening?

To support activities related to the continued planning and design of the Marten Falls First Nation Community Access Road, field crews will carry out vegetation clearing activities within the study area. This work is to support aggregate permitting activities and investigations at targeted water crossing sites for bridges along the proposed Community Access Road.

### What to expect

#### Aerial Wolverine Sweep

Wolverine den sweeps will be starting in advance of vegetation clearing work. The purpose of this field program is to confirm the presence / absence of active wolverine dens within the study area.

If denning is confirmed, work in the area will be avoided.

#### Vegetation Clearing Works

Following the wolverine sweep (and after it has been determined that there are no wolverine dens in the work area), vegetation clearing will commence. Field crews will be accessing sites within the study area by helicopter—you may see helicopters in the area.

Crews will complete clearing at isolated locations to facilitate helipad sites, allowing safe helicopter access and work zones for borehole drilling (for water monitoring).



## When?

- **Aerial Wolverine Sweeps:** Crews will mobilize on April 11 or 12, 2026, and start the first flyover on April 12 or 13, 2026. This work is heavily dependent on weather; therefore, the schedule is subject to change.
- **Vegetation Clearing:** Pending a positive result of the aerial sweeps, vegetation clearing will start on April 15, 2026, after the wolverine sweeps are done in each area.

The work will take approximately 2 weeks to complete and will conclude no later than April 30, 2026.
